General Information

ABCD Youth Pre and Post Scan Questionnaires

Participants are administered a pre-scan questionnaire (abcd_ypre101) immediately prior to scanning, on their current state of arousal (sleepy, happy, scared, awake, upset, angry, excited, tired, sleepy and sad) using a five-point Likert scale: Very slightly or not at all=1; A little=2; Moderately=3; Quite a bit=4; and Extremely=5.

This Scan questionnaire is administered again at the end of the scan (abcd_ypsq101).

If the scan protocol is administered over 2 days/sessions then the participant is administered the questionnaire again before and after the scan (abcd_ypre201, abcd_ypsq201, respectively).

Y MID Post Scan questionnaire: This questionnaire asks the participant to rate how they felt when viewing the different cues and receiving the different outcomes during the MID task to determine the effectiveness and value of wins and losses.
